Sustainable Futures Festival 2024 - Terms & Conditions:

APPROVED PRODUCTS

1. Goods and services must meet the criteria of the event, as stated above.
2. The event is plastic free. Do not distribute goods or products in disposable plastic wrapping.

MARKET SITE

3. Site fees are: Commercial entities- \$125, Not for Profit- \$25, Individuals showing vehicles - \$0 per 3mx3m site.
4. The allocation of a site is at the discretion of the event organisers.
5. Stall sites are 3m x 3m. Larger sites may be arranged but will need to be paid for.
6. Market stalls are not to restrict public access to public facilities.
7. The stallholder must provide their own equipment including marquee/tent/umbrella, protective floor matting and matting under legs of marquees, tables and chairs, weights (sand bags) and wet weather protection. All displays will be located on hard surfaces, either within buildings (concrete) or on tarmac for vehicles and containers.
8. All displays must be presented in a tidy and professional manner.
9. The stallholder must ensure their site is always attended, presentable, professional and safe and that they are courteous to management, other stallholders and visitors.
10. The stallholder must leave their site in a clean state and all waste must be removed. No liquid is to be discharged at the site. Eg., ice and water from eskies
11. Any banners or bunting to be contained within stall perimeter.

ATTENDANCES AND WEATHER

12. Sites must be set up and ready to trade at least 30 minutes prior to the advertised opening time of the event.
13. The stallholder cannot have another person selling their product on their behalf unless they have knowledge of the product on how it was produced, where sourced and how to use the product.
14. Inability to attend the event must be notified as soon as practical before the event by contacting the Event Coordinator by phone or email.
15. The event will operate in varying weather conditions. In the event of extreme weather conditions cancellation of the markets will be at the discretion of the event organisers. Stall holders will be advised of this decision.

VEHICLES AND PARKING

16. Stallholders will be required to set up and unpack between 6.00 – 8.45 am and move their vehicle to a suitable car park.
17. No vehicles will be able to enter or remain in the Event area at any time, except for emergencies and emergency vehicles.

INSURANCES

18. All stallholders must hold a current Public & Property Liability Insurance, a copy of which must be provided to the Coordinator prior to the stallholder commencing trade.
19. All business and for-profit stallholders must hold current Public & Property Liability Insurance to the value of \$20 million.
20. Non-for-profit and community group stallholders must hold current Public & Property Liability Insurance to the value of \$10 million.
21. Display vehicle owners acknowledge that during Sustainable Futures Festival 2024, the display vehicle owner waives, releases and forever discharges all claims against Sustainable Futures Festival 2024 organisers for all liability for any death, injuries, property damages, losses or claims, whether known and unknown, which arise during or result from Sustainable Futures Festival 2024.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

22. Stallholders have a responsibility to protect their own and others' health and safety.
23. Sustainable Futures Festival 2024 organisers accepts no liability for damages or costs associated with stallholders, and their products and by signing this agreement, stallholders indemnify Sustainable Futures Festival 2024 organisers related costs and damages.
